# Eurell confident O'Tauto will see out Guineas mile

Progressive three-year-old could be Sydney bound provided all goes well at Flemington on Saturday

reg Eurell has no doubts as to whether improving three-year-old O'Tauto (O'Lonhro) will see out the trip in tomorrow's Australian Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington, with the gelding set to venture beyond 1400 metres for the first time in his lightly-raced career.

O'Tauto has won two of his five starts to date, while his staying on third in the CS Hayes Stakes (Gr 3, 1400m) at his last start gave Eurell every indication that tomorrow's step up in distance will see the gelding eke out further improvement.

"I was very happy with the way he hit the line [last start]," Eurell told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"He had had five weeks between runs. There was nothing that went wrong. I just thought that he'd had a couple of runs and it gave us an opportunity to give him a week out on the grass and on the walker to have a little freshen.

"If he runs well on Saturday we may think of sending him up to Sydney which was half the reason to give him a little bit of a break.

"You look at horses and envisage them hitting a distance they will be suited to and I believe the distance and the tempo will suit him down to the ground." Continued on page 2>>

# Design and default sees inbreeding to Danehill come to the fore

A 450-strong catalogue comprising some of the best yearlings to come on to the Australian market awaits buyers at this year's Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale in early April.

As ever, there is representation from a wide array of Australia's major stallions alongside a smattering of leading European and Japanese names. Many of those catalogued are naturally extremely well connected.

However, a total of 93 youngsters are also inbred within four generations to Danehill. This isn't a rare phenomenon across the thoroughbred population. Such was Danehill's influence on the breed and subsequent popularity, particularly in Australia, inbreeding to the great horse was always likely to become a well-trodden avenue.

The makeup of this year's Easter catalogue reflects just that. According to Arion Pedigrees, there are a total of 7,078 named foals worldwide inbred within five generations to Danehill. Of those foals, 4,997 have run and 2,538 (50.8 per cent) have won, among them 131 (2.6 per cent to runners) at stakes level.

O'Tauto has already registered one victory at Flemington and Eurell is even mooting a further step up in trip for the gelding, providing all goes well in tomorrow's Group 1 contest.

"He has certainly got the ability and I think he is going to turn into a really nice horse," Eurell said.

"I was very happy with the way he relaxed last start. The mile I have no doubt in my mind but there is always a question mark once you step up.

"His pedigree suggests he would get the 2000 metres. At some stage we would tip our toe in the water and see how we go.

"He has always been a lovely style of horse and a good mover. He has got a good, clean, neat action and the jockeys who have ridden him say he has given them a great feel.

"He is very new to the caper but I think he is improving bit by bit with each run in getting a little bit more race savvy."

Meanwhile, Mike Moroney has been left rueing a luckless barrier draw for fellow Australian Guineas contender Chapada (Bullet Train), with the gelding set to jump widest of all in gate 16 for tomorrow's \$1 million contest.

Having rounded off his Spring campaign with a third place finish behind the re-opposing Extra Brut (Domesday) and Stars Of Carrum (Fiorente) in the Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m), Chapada resumed with a seventh in the CS Hayes Stakes where he again drew the widest barrier of all.

"It is very, very disappointing but you can't do much about barrier draws," Moroney said.

"He's got gate speed so we could go either way. It's just a matter of studying the field a little bit more.

"I thought his first-up run was good. He kept running to the line and he wasn't that far away. He's well up to a race like this, without a doubt. Once he gets to a mile he's pretty competitive from that distance up.

"It just would have helped if we had drawn a barrier."

Moroney has elected to keep Chapada at home in Melbourne having also had the option to wait a week for the Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m), a race that would have enabled the three-year-old to gain experience racing in the clockwise direction before the Rosehill Guineas (Gr 1, 2000m) and Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2400m).

However, the Flemington trainer has no concerns about the gelding heading to Sydney for the staying features off the back of tomorrow's Australian Guineas.

"We've done a bit of work right handed with him and he looks really good going right handed," Moroney added.

"So we just believe he didn't need as much practice and we're just happy to keep him closer to home for at least one more run."

# Guineas meeting brought forward due to hot weather

Tomorrow's Australian Guineas meeting at Flemington has been brought forward to begin in the morning due to forecasted temperatures of 36 degrees.

Saturday's nine-race program will begin at 10.55am (AEDT), one and a half hours earlier than originally scheduled, with the final race to jump at 3.20pm in a bid to avoid the hottest part of the day.

Gaps between races have also been reduced from 35 and 40 minutes to 30 and 35 minutes and horses will only be required on course two hours before their races, as opposed to the usual three.

Racing Victoria will invoke its Procedure for Racing in Hot Weather Policy to ensure the health and well-being of horses and participants.

"Under the Policy, an additional vet is in attendance to assist in monitoring the condition of horses, large containers of ice water are made available at locations around the racecourse and horses are required in the mounting yard for reduced periods of time," RV said.

"The Victoria Racing Club will also implement additional measures including misting fans in horse areas, rostering a dedicated staff member to assist in equine welfare measures in the horse stalls, and bottled water and icy-poles being readily available for all racing participants."

#### Nakeeta Jane begins Oaks path

Nakeeta Jane (So You Think) will take one step closer to the Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) when she lines up in the Surround Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Randwick tomorrow. The Mark Newnhamtrained filly was last seen winning the Light Fingers Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) and she will jump from barrier six with Joshua Parr booked to take the ride. "Saturday will decide what the third run is," Newnham said. "It will either be the Phar Lap Stakes or the Coolmore, and a rough possibility is the Randwick Guineas which would mean backing her up the following week."

#### Mr Quickie kicks off Derby prep

Mr Quickie (Shamus Award) begins a campaign at Flemington that his new trainer hopes can lead to a win in the South Australian Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) in May. The former Darren Weir-trained three-year-old lines up for Phillip Stokes for the first time in tomorrow's Seppelt Wines Plate

(1400m). "He had a trial at Cranbourne and I was really happy with it as he finished it off lovely," Stokes said. "He's not wound up for this but he's still got a lot of residual fitness from his previous preparation. He came to me in great order. He's a very easy horse to train. He's got a great attitude. In his trial the other day he was out the back and he finished off well over the line. I think he's an each-way chance on Saturday."

# Relaxed Winx ready for world record bid

Winx (Street Cry) will bid to win her 23rd Group 1, 31st consecutive victory and record a fourth straight win in the Chipping Norton Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Randwick tomorrow. "Over five or six years, we've noticed the changes," Chris Waller said. "Comparing her to a person, she is a little bit smarter. She knows where the winning post is. She has become used to winning. She knows what she's doing. Hughie rides a lot of horses and I train a lot of horses and you're forever saying, 'Why didn't this horse win today?' or 'How come

this horse can't win from that position?' But Winx breaks all those rules. She's overcoming track conditions, luck in running, sectional times - which is a big thing in sport."

#### Dixie Blossoms on hunt for third Guy Walter

Like Winx, Dixie Blossoms (Street Sense) will be out to defend a title at Randwick tomorrow, with Ron Quinton's high-class mare on the hunt for a third straight win in the Guy Walter Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m). The six-year-old mare has not been sighted since finishing seventh in the Craven Plate (Gr 3, 2000m) and she will jump from barrier five with James McDonald booked to take the ride. "The thing you've got to think about a little bit is they're probably not going to get much better at this age and you've got to be a little bit fearful of the younger mares coming up," Quinton said. "But there's been no indication in the stable that she's not at her top so we've just got to wait and see with bated breath on Saturday."

Last-start Eskimo Prince Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) winner Gem Song (Your Song) is over the skin infection that ruled him out of Saturday's Hobartville Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) and will look to get his Randwick Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) campaign back on track in tomorrow's Liverpool City Cup (Gr 3, 1300m) at Randwick. "Now he's got to back up and the program for him has changed, but fitness-wise he's good," Kris Lees said. "He's taking on older horses. It's not ideal but he'll go well."

#### High hopes for Ever Loyal

New Zealand-based trained Tony Pike is confident Ever Loyal (Sebring) can put in a good performance in the Liverpool City Cup at Randwick tomorrow. "His racing manners last season weren't quite there," Pike said. "He was a little bit aggressive and just did a few things wrong and he probably struggled to get 1600 metres. He had an injury enforced layoff and he has probably come back better than ever. His two runs resuming off a 12-month break have been exceptional. His sectionals have been very good, so I think it is time to step up in class and have a crack in Sydney on Saturday."

# Ready To Roam hopes to grab Jewel spot

Ready To Roam (Better Than Ready) gets a chance to grab some of the spotlight away from his more high profile Tony Gollan-trained stablemates when he runs in the Emerald Jewel Prelude 2YO (1200m) for colts and geldings at Doomben tomorrow. A win will assure him a place in the \$500,000 Aquis Two-Year-Old Jewel (1200m) at the Gold Coast on March 16, having finished an unlucky second on debut at Doomben. "He was the unlucky runner in that race because he had no luck getting a run at the 200 metres," Gollan said. "I have had the Aquis Jewel in mind for him all along and Saturday is his test.

# Best Of Days sidelined after bleeding

Shortly after being given the all-clear to start in the Blamey Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m), Best Of Days (Azamour) has had his campaign shut down by a bleeding attack. The Godolphin-raced five-year-old went to Sandown on Thursday

for the second of two enforced jump-outs after staying in the barriers in the Futurity Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) at Caulfield last Saturday. He had passed the first test on Wednesday and successfully completed the second before the bleed was discovered. "It's a great shame as he's such a talented galloper who was in great shape to continue a big autumn campaign," Cummings said on Godolphin's Twitter account. "He will have a good rest back home and hopefully he will get his chance to repeat his spring carnival feats from last year when winning the Kennedy Mile."

#### Nikolic found guilty in Fiji

Former trainer John Nikolic has been found guilty of importing drugs and possessing a weapon by a Fijian court. Nikolic was arrested with his wife, Yvette Nikolic, whilst on their yacht 'Shenanigans' in June last year. Fijian customs officers found quantities of cocaine, illicit drug tablets, two handguns and 112 rounds of ammunition aboard the vessel. Nikolic pleaded not guilty to five charges when the trial commenced in January. Two drug charges were dropped during the trial but the three other charges, one relating to possession of a firearm and two related to possession and importing drugs, were maintained by the prosecution. Nikolic appeared before the High Court in Suva on Thursday morning where three assessors made their determination before it was confirmed by the judge - Justice Daniel Goundar.

# RV confirms Victorian trainer death

Racing Victoria has confirmed the death of a licensed trainer on Thursday morning, but the governing body has not yet released the name of the trainer publicly as some members of his family have not been notified. "We are aware of the tragic passing of a licensed trainer who is reported to have fallen from a horse this morning in country Victoria," RV said in a statement. "Our thoughts and prayers are with their family and friends, some of whom have yet to be notified so we are unable to identify the person in question at this time."

#### Wilkinson moves to Yulong

Expanding breeding and racing business Yulong Investments has announced Luke Wilkinson as their Bloodstock manager. Wilkinson's appointment at Yulong ends his nine-year tenure as Bloodstock manager for leading Caulfield-based trainer Mick Price. "Luke was the first person that came to mind for the position," Yulong Investments chief operating officer Sam Fairgray said in a statement. "He has a good brain for thoroughbreds, is highly regarded and respected amongst his colleagues and having been with Mick Price for nine years, it's a great testament to his loyalty and professionalism. He will be a valuable asset to Yulong, and a great assistance to me."

#### Elate ready for Oaks assault

Co-trainer Roger James will be hoping Elate (Savabeel) can run well in the Sunline Vase (Gr 3, 2100m) at Ellerslie tomorrow, which will be her final lead-up into the New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m). Elate will be out to add a second stakes win to her CV, having taken out the Oaks Prelude (Listed, 1800m) on February 2. "I was pretty happy with her win the other day. She's lacked a bit of luck a couple of times. We took bad luck out of play last time and she was strong to the line," James said. "She's trained on very well. I've thought for a long time she was an Oaks filly. She's quite aggressive in her work but she relaxes in her races and she always finds the line."

# Tiger Silk aiming for first stakes victory

The Richard Collett-trained Tiger Silk (All American) will be aiming for his first stakes victory

in the Mufhasa Fasttrack Stakes (Listed, 1300m) at Ellerslie tomorrow. "She's in really good order," Collett said. "I was really happy with her run last start and she won well the start before that here at Counties. We ran her again at Ellerslie the other day and brought her back from 1400 to 1200 metres, just because she was given a long time between races." Tiger Silk ran on to finish sixth, but Collett was happy with the run considering she only found clear air late in the piece. "She just never saw daylight, it was a good effort," he said. "She probably would have run second if she got clear earlier over 1200 metres."

#### 164 for Dubawi

Darley stalwart Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) was provided with his 164th stakes winner yesterday courtesy of Ispolini's (3 g ex Giants Play by Giant's Causeway) victory in the Nad Al Sheba Trophy (Gr 3, 2800m) at Meydan. The Charlie Appleby-trained gelding led home a 1-2-3 for

both Godolphin and Dubawi to continue the recent good form of the operation, beating Red Galileo (Dubawi) by 11 lengths with a further 12 lengths back to Bin Battuta (Dubawi) in third. Dubawi is currently standing at Dalham Hall Stud in Newmarket for a fee of £250,000. Race favourite Bruntdland (Dubawi), also raced by Godolphin, was pulled up through injury.

# Sporting puts in a Classic display at Meydan

The Simon Crisford-trained Sporting Chance (2 c Kodiac - Elpida, by Giant's Causeway) registered his third victory at stakes level yesterday when taking out the Meydan Classic (Listed, 1600m). The three-year-old prevailed in a blanket finish, showing a game attitude to get the better of Golden Jaguar (Animal Kingdom) by a neck, with the same distance back to Irish Trilogy (Gregorian) in third. Kodiac (Danehill) is currently standing at Tally-Ho Stud in Ireland for a career high fee of €65,000.



he Gerald Ryan-trained Villami (Foxwedge) made a very encouraging debut at Rosehill on Wednesday and looks to have a promising future on the track.

The filly showed good early pace to cross from barrier eight and assume her position at the head of affairs, before slipping the field approaching the 200 metre mark.

Villami then showed a game and determined attitude under a predominantly hands and heels ride from Brenton Avdulla, effortlessly holding the sole challenge of the Chris Waller-trained Starla (Snitzel) to score by a length and a quarter.

A \$425,000 purchase by her trainer at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, the filly had previously won two barrier trials and has drawn favourable comparisons with previous Ryan-trained stars Melito (Redoute's Choice) and Snitzerland (Snitzel).

The most expensive yearling by her sire to sell at auction in 2018, Villami is one of seven foals to race, all winners, out of the dual Group 3-winning mare Galapagos Girl (Dehere).

Galapagos Girl was also placed at Group 1 level and is a half-sister to Procrastinate (Jade Hunter), herself the dam of five stakes winners including Laissefaire (Danehill), a dual Champion Older Female Sprinter in South Africa, and Time Thief (Redoute's Choice), the sire of recent Black Caviar Lightning Stakes (Gr 1, 1000m) winner In Her Time.



# Design and default sees inbreeding to Danehill come to the fore

As ever, there is representation from a wide array of Australia's major stallions alongside a smattering of leading European and Japanese names. Many of those catalogued are naturally extremely well connected.

However, a total of 93 youngsters are also inbred within four generations to Danehill.

This isn't a rare phenomenon across the thoroughbred population. Such was Danehill's influence on the breed and subsequent popularity, particularly in Australia, inbreeding to the great horse was always likely to become a well-trodden avenue.

The makeup of this year's Easter catalogue reflects just that. According to Arion Pedigrees, there are a total of 7,078 named foals worldwide inbred within five generations to Danehill. Of those foals, 4,997 have run and 2,538 (50.8 per cent) have won, among them 131 (2.6 per cent to runners) at stakes level.

Such hefty numbers are the product of both design and default.

As a game-changer who was a reliable source of hardy performers, many gifted with juvenile pace, Danehill would most likely be regarded in many quarters as an excellent influence to double up on. Against that, such is his presence within the breed that for some reinforcing Danehill within a pedigree is the result of lack of choice.

Events from last weekend, when he appeared in the backgrounds of Australian Group 1 winners Alizee, Booker and Melody Belle alongside the high-profile Group 2 winners The Autumn Sun and Time To Reign, serve to confirm that while his line remains one key to success, sometimes he's also not that easy to escape.

In that respect, it was interesting to hear Yulong Investment's chief operating officer Sam Fairgray allude to a Danehill-free pedigree as being one of the appealing aspects of dual Group 1 winner Grunt, in whom Yulong purchased a 51 per cent share earlier this week.

In all, the statistics paint an average picture of inbreeding to Danehill. However, supporters of the pattern will point to several recent high-profile successful examples, notably Godolphin's star mare Alizee.

The strapping homebred notched up her eighth win on Saturday when overcoming a wide trip to defeat the likes of Hartnell and Redkirk Warrior in the Futurity Stakes at Caulfield. It was the mare's third career Group 1 victory for James Cummings following earlier wins in the Coolmore Legacy and Flight Stakes, and brought her career earnings to close to \$2 million. It also set her on track for next month's inaugural \$5m All Star Mile at Flemington, for which she is now a strong favourite.

Alizee is by far the best runner sired by the former shuttler Sepoy, who currently stands for a career low of \$11,000 for Darley in Victoria. By contrast, her dam Essaouira is rapidly becoming one of the important mares within the Darley band as the dam of fellow Group 1 winner Astern and promising juvenile Tassort alongside Alizee.

Alizee is inbred 3x3 to Danehill via Watchful, the dam of Sepoy, and Exceed And Excel, sire of Essaouira. Incidentally, one of the first major runners to carry such inbreeding was a Darleybred relation to Sepoy, Guelph; by Exceed And Excel and inbred 2x3, she was a top two-year-old who wound up as a four-time Group 1 winner.

Since then, the number of Group 1 winners inbred to Danehill has grown steadily to its current level of 13, and ranges from those other Australasian performers such as Danzdanzdance and Amphitrite to northern hemisphere Classic prospects La Pelosa and Wonderment.

The same pattern is also seen in the backgrounds of The Mission (by Choisir and out of a Redoute's Choice mare) and Seabrook (by the late Fastnet Rock stallion Hinchinbrook and out of a mare by Don Eduardo), both winners of the Group 1 Champagne Stakes. In relation to Hinchinbrook, reinforcing Danehill also worked in the case of his top Hong Kong sprinter Beat The Clock and this season's Magic Millions 2yo Classic winner Unite And Conquer - that particular colt takes matters a step further as the owner of three Danehill crosses.

As the accompanying table shows, there have been nine Group/Grade 1 winners over the past year inbred to Danehill. It's quite a weighty list but then the opportunity for it take hold is certainly there, especially as Danehill continues to recede further into pedigrees. With that in mind, it has to be said that right now the volume of results aren't there to be able to call it an advantageous formula, even allowing for the presence of Alizee, Sunlight and Wonderment et al.

Alizee's dam, Essaouira, is relatively young at 11 years old considering she is already regarded as an elite mare. Out of Group 2

winner Alizes, Essaouira looked very smart for trainer Lee Freedman when the six-length winner of her debut at Moonee Valley, but was restricted to just one further outing when sixth in a Listed event at Caulfield.

She was retired to stud and initially sent to Lonhro, to whom she foaled the Group 3-placed Mogador. Astern, the 2016 Golden Rose Stakes winner, was her third foal and is now a member of Darley's Kelvinside roster in Australia; the son of Medaglia D'Oro also shuttles to their Kentucky base, where he covered 116 mares last season.

Alizee is her fourth foal and is followed by the exciting two-year-old Tassort, a valuable early flag-bearer for Brazen Beau who ran second to Time To Reign in the Group 2 Silver Slipper Stakes at Rosehill just hours before Alizee's Futurity win on Saturday.

The mare also has a yearling sister to Astern named Tangier. The success of Essaouira also pays tribute to the role played by her sire, the venerable shuttler Exceed And Excel. The son of Danehill has just embarked on his 17th consecutive season on his latest shuttle trip to Kildangan Stud. During that time, he has sired 156 stakes winners, among them Excelebration and Margot Did in this part of the world and the likes of Helmet and Guelph in Australasia.

Several of his sons are now useful stallions in their own right but he is now also gaining real momentum as a broodmare sire, not just through Essaouira but also via Seeking Solace and Believe'N'Succeed, between them responsible for two of this season's more exciting prospects in Ten Sovereigns and Anthony Van Dyck.

# Profile Ryan Arnel - Stonehouse Thoroughbreds

#### How do you feel your 2019 draft compares to your 2018 draft?

We had a smaller draft last year for Melbourne, this year our numbers have doubled. Working with the horses over the past few months it definitely feels like there's some winners amongst them!

#### What type of yearling do you feel suits this sale?

I don't feel there is necessarily a type when you look at graduates of the sale. A world class older sprinter in Santa Ana Lane (Lope De Vega), Group 1-winning two-year-olds Written By (Written Tycoon) and Seabrook (Hinchinbrook), plus Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Fawkner (Reset) are all graduates, just to name a couple.

#### Which lots are your stand out colts?

It's hard to pick stand outs with both our colts and our fillies as I feel we have something to suit all levels of buying and racing. But if I was to pick a couple of colts, Lot 346, the Exceed and Excel (Danehill) ex Nediym's Glow (General Nediym) is the only colt in the sale by the sire and he has some real presence about him. Lot 1, Headwater (Exceed And Excel) ex Umaquest (Umatilla) is also the only colt by the sire in session 1, he has shown us some serious ability and is well-related being out of a stakes winning mare who has thrown all winners, including two stakes winners with the Henry Dwyer-trained Alexandra Dreaming (Written Tycoon) soon to show us her potential at stakes level racing.

#### Which lots are your stand out fillies?

The same as above, we have two very nice Brazen Beau (I Am Invincible) fillies (Lot 126 and 221) both well-related and showing us great potential through their yearling preparation, as well as a well-related Fastnet Rock (Danehill) filly out of Lovetorn (Giant's Causeway) (Lot 284), who is a really classy filly. A sneaky in Session 2 I think is Lot 545, a Dundeel (High Chaparral) filly out of Aromas (Starcraft). She is definitely one to keep an eye on - a great action, athletic and excellent temperament.

# Which lot do you feel has improved most since the beginning of the prep?

We have a Headwater filly in session 2 (Lot 741) that has thrived through her preparation. She has taken to every bit of her exercise and daily prep life.

#### Who do you think will be the leading sire at the sale?

I would imagine as most sales, the top few lots are majority by proven sires. I think Zoustar (Northern Meteor) will no doubt be up there, Written Tycoon (Iglesia) would be great to see being a Victorian sire himself.

# Of the first season sires, which have impressed you and what do you like about their progeny?

So far, Headwater. I've heard good reports of them in previous sales this year and what we have on the farm I have liked on type, weanlings and yearlings.

# Hectic tempo in Oakleigh Plate played into the hands of the backmarkers and tested Nature Strip

he hectic tempo in Saturday's
Oakleigh Plate (Gr 1, 1100m) at
Caulfield played into the hands of
the backmarkers – the first nine
past the post, with the exception of third-placed
Eduardo (Host), coming from between seventh
to 15th at the home turn.

The pace was set by the speedster and favourite Nature Strip (Nicconi) and an examination of his sectional times soon reveals why he tired over the final 200 metres to finish (4.4 lengths) tenth.

Clocked from the 1000 metres to the 200 metre mark, Nature Strip's 200 metre breakdown was 10.19, 10.22 (400m in 20.41), 10.79 (600m in 31.20) and 11.11 for a very fast 42.31 for that 800 metre section.

It would take a super effort to sustain that sort of pace for much further and Nature Strip then clocked 12.52 for his final 200 metres, which still gave him a highly respectable 54.83 for a final 1000 metres.

The overall time for the 1100 metre journey :

of the Oakleigh Plate was also very fast – 1:01.94 being only 0.21 seconds outside of the Caulfield track record.

To demonstrate further, Saturday's time of 1:01.94 represents a fast 200 metre rate of 11.26, equivalent to 1:07.57 for 1200 metres.

A winner of nine of 14 starts, Nature Strip has the potential to achieve more success and at high levels, but realistically that would be more likely if his new trainer Chris Waller can get him to manage his speed in a more effective manner.

Already racing in a crossover noseband, one wonders what might bring about that change but if anyone can do that surely it would be Waller, who has already achieved so much in racing in his outstanding career.

Outside of the focus on the fast pace, credit is due the winner Booker (Written Tycoon), a talented four-year-old mare who had the ability to track that tempo and come from tenth to win by just under a length.

Booker produced some of the fastest :

closing sectionals of the race, with her last 1000 metres in 53.82, last 800 metres in 43.37, last 600 metres in 32.99 and final 400 metres in 22.19.

Godolphin-raced colt Encryption (Lonhro) came from 12th at the home turn to take second, clocking 53.94 (last 1000m), 43.35 (last 800m), 33.01 (last 600m) with his final 400 metres in 22.22.

Only a nose further back was the lightly-raced and very smart sprinter Eduardo, who again demonstrated his ability in being the only runner to race near to the hot tempo and finish as close as he did, less than a length from the winner.

Eduardo's 200 metre breakdown was impressive: 10.27, 10.30 (400m in 20.57), 10.85 (600m in 31.42), 11.00 (800m in 42.42) with his final 200 metres in 11.80 to give him a fast last 1000 metres in 54.22.

Trained at Cranbourne by Sarah Zschoke, Eduardo has featured in On The Watch previously, highlighting his exceptional pace and ability.



Eduardo is a five-year-old gelding, who has now raced six times for three wins, two seconds and a third, with Saturday's excellent first-up effort really impressing, especially after working from his difficult barrier (17) on the strong tempo and then fighting on gamely.

Many of the Oakleigh Plate runners will now head to the Newmarket Handicap (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington on Saturday week, where a rematch over its famous straight course should certainly provide some interesting racing.

The other Group 1 feature on Saturday saw the Godolphin-raced filly Lyre (Lonho) provide Godolphin with another noteworthy victory this season in taking out the Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m).

After not showing any early pace, Lyre settled in second last place in the 14-horse field, and after being wide out at the home turn, she finished strongly to beat Lankan Star (Nicconi) by a half-length with the South Australiantrained colt Free Of Debt (Unencumbered) a long neck away third.

The time for the 1200 metre journey was : Stokes-trained

1:09.39 in a race that featured a quick mid-race pace, where the leader I Am Immortal (I Am Invincible) clocked 43.92 for his 800 metres (from the 1000m to the 200m) before finishing seventh.

Lyre was timed to run her final 1000 metres in 55.93, last 800 metres in 45.45, last 600 metres in 34.57 with her final 400 metres in 23 26

However, some of the quickest closing sectionals in the race were recorded by the Jason Warren-trained filly Brooklyn Hustle (Starspangledbanner), who came from 14th at the 600 metres to finish (1.4 lengths) fifth.

Brooklyn Hustle clocked 55.93 (last 1000m), 45.37 (last 800m), 34.69 (last 600m) with her final 400 metres in 23.40.

The unlucky runner of the race was the Ciaron Maher and David Eustace-trained filly Loving Gaby (I Am Invincible), who ran on in restricted room for (1.9 lengths) sixth. She was timed to run her last 1000 metres in 56.24.

Earlier in the day, the progressive Phillip three-year-old Terbium (Terango) advanced from winning a maiden (1100m) at Strathalbyn on January 16 to take out the Zeditave Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m) and remain unbeaten after four starts

He raced close to the leaders three deep and after going to the front at the 200 metres, Terbium showed his class in holding off the Group 1-placed colt Zousain (Zoustar) and win by a half-length in a time of 1:09.07.

Terbium's 200 metre breakdown (from the 1000m) was: 11.05, 11.08 (400m in 22.13), 11.54 (600m in 33.67), 11.00 (800m in 44.67) with his final 200 metres in 11.63 for a last 1000 metres in 56.30.

The runner-up Zousain, who has having his first start since finishing second in the Coolmore Stud Stakes (registered as Ascot Vale Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m) at Flemington in November, did race keenly in the early part of the race and his closing times were certainly sound.

Zousain clocked 56.45 (last 1000m), 45.25 (last 800m) 34.23 (last 600m), 22.68 (last 400m) with his final 200 metres in 11.63.
